AN ORDINANCE OF THE OTTER ROCK WATER DISTRICT, AMENDING THE OTTER ROCK WATER DISTRICT RATES AND REGULATIONS FOR WATER SERVICE (CODIFICATION OF ORDINANCES 2017-01 AND 2017-02), CLARIFYING THE CIRCUMSTANCES FOR SUBSIDIZED TURN ON/ TURN OFF CHARGES, CLARIFYING NEW CONNECTION FEES AND CHARGES; SPECIFYING THE TIMING FOR CONNECTION; CLARIFYING PAID FEES AND CHARGES WILL BECOME A CREDIT RUNNING WITH THE LAND USABLE TOWARD FUTURE SYSTEM CHARGES; PROVIDING FOR A VARIANCE PROCESS FOR RELIEF FROM REGULATIONS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Annotated to show deletions and additions to the code sections being modified. Deletions are **bold lined through** and additions are **bold underlined**.

 WHEREAS, the Otter Rock Water District (hereinafter "District") is a properly formed Domestic Water Supply District created under ORS Chapter 264; and

WHEREAS, the District is expressly authorized by Oregon Revised Statutes Chapter 264 to adopt regulations, rates, fees and charges concerning the provision of water service; and

WHEREAS, The District fully complied with ORS 198.540 and ORS 198.550 procedures for Ordinance adoption; and

THE OTTER ROCK WATER DISTRICT ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Clarification of Subsidized Rate. The Turn on / Turn Off rate for nonpayment is clarified in numbered paragraph 7 in Table 1 adopted in Section 1.01.010 (Water Rates) to be \$50.00 and not the "all other" \$500.00 rate which was adopted to apply to seasonal requests for service disconnection, as follows:

7. Turn on and Turn Off charges for **non-payment and** replacement/repair of shut off valves and lines: subsidized at \$50.00 turn on. \$50.00 turn off. All other On or Off service charges set at \$500.00 per service.

SECTION 2 Clarification of Connection fees and SDC. The new connection fees and charges specified in numbered paragraph 8, Table 1 adopted in Section 1.01.010 (Water Rates) is clarified as it includes the previously established \$750.00 fee for staff time to make the physical connection, as follows:

8. New water service application/connection fee: \$5650.00 (plus cost of line installation and water meter) (New Fee includes previously established \$750.00 fee for staff time and materials).

SECTION 3. Prohibited Connection; Application and Payment for Service Connection Time Limit for Connection and Credit to Run with the Land. Section 1.01.020 (Application for Water) is hereby amended to specify the timing for payment of connection fees and System Development Charges, the time limit to use the service, and credit toward future increases in SDC rates and connection charges in the event connection is not timely made to the system, as follows:

A. No person may connect to the water or sewer system of the city unless the appropriate system development charge has been paid or the lien or installment payment method has been applied for and approved.

Applications for the use of water must be signed by the property owner and made on <u>B.</u> the Water District's approved application form, which can be secured at the office of the District. By signing said application form the applicant agrees to conform to the rules and regulations of the Water District as a condition for being served with water. A request or application for service does not, in itself, constitute a contract until the requirements contained in the District's regulations are satisfied and the District actually delivers or is ready to deliver service to customer. If the application involves an existing service a service charge of \$25.00 or such greater amount as established by District Resolution, shall be paid in advance. If said application involves a new service, the applicant shall pay the current such request for service charge together with the actual cost to the district for providing said service. The service will include cost of a meter for all new connections. A minimum service connection fee as established by Ordinance or Resolution, plus any amount which is deemed to be due by virtue of Section 1.01.030 of these regulations is due in advance prior to commencing the work of installing the service. Connection to the system and commencement of payment of the applicable monthly water rate shall be made within one year of the application for service and payment of the connection fee or building permit expiration whichever occurs first. Failure to make the connection in the time specified shall subject the owner to review of available capacity and any applicable intervening increase in connection fees and charges Previously paid fees and charges shall be a credit which runs with the land.

C. All pipe sizes are interior diameter. No application for a service to a building or structure will be accepted if the plumbing in said building or structure does not comply with applicable rules, regulations and codes.

SECTION 4 Variance to Regulations for Demonstrated Hardship. A new Section 1.01.140 1 2 (Variance to Regulations and Fees) is hereby added to the Codification of Otter Rock Water 3 District Rates and Regulations for Water Service, as follows: 4 5 1.01.140 VARIANCE TO REGULATIONS AND TIMEFRAMES FOR COMPLAINCE 6 A. The Board, by unanimous vote, may authorize variances from 7 8 regulations and timeframes specified for compliance, where it can be shown that, owing to special and unusual circumstances related to a 9 specific piece of property, that strict application of the Board's 10 regulations and timeframes for compliance would cause an undue or 11 12 unnecessary hardship. No variances shall be granted to health and safety regulations of the district, including construction standards. 13 Variances are only permitted to regulations and to the period of time 14 for compliance with regulations. In granting a variance, the Board 15 may attach conditions which it finds necessary to protect the fiscal and 16 regulatory interests of the District or otherwise to achieve the 17 18 protection of District and owners of real property in the District. 19

B. A variance may be granted only in the event that all the following circumstances exist:

A. Exceptional or extraordinary circumstances apply to the property which do not apply generally to other properties in the same zone or vicinity and result from lot size or shape legally existing prior to the effective date of Ordinance 2017-02 or other circumstances over which the applicant has no control;

B. The variance should not be materially detrimental to the purposes of these regulations, or otherwise conflict with the objectives of any District fiscal or regulatory policy;

C. A variance application must be submitted in writing by the applicant and the applicant must personally appear before the Board and explain why compliance with the District's regulations operates as a hardship.

SECTION 5 Findings Adopted. The findings contained in the Whereas Clauses of this ordinance together with the competent substantial evidence in the record of this legislative proceeding are incorporated into this section by reference as if fully set forth herein, and are adopted in support of this legislative action.

1 2 **SECTION 6. Severability**. The sections, subsections, paragraphs and clauses of this ordinance are severable. The invalidity of one section, subsection, paragraph, 3 4 or clause shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, subsections, paragraphs and clauses. 5 6 **SECTION 7. Ordinance Effective Date / Emergency.** 7 Inconsistent Ordinances and Resolutions concerning rates and charges must be made 8 consistent with the rates lawfully established during the budget process and 9 otherwise in accordance with notice and hearing procedures of ORS 264.312. 10 Accordingly, an emergency is declared in order that this Ordinance may be in force 11 and effect from and after passage by the Governing Body. In addition to clarification 12 of rates, fees and charges, a variance process is necessary to address hardship 13 situations presented to the Board.
